



Live Service Guidelines

- Stay home if you or anyone in your household is sick, or even feels slightly sick.
We will continue to live stream services until we establish a new normal.
- Masks are now required upon entering the building and in all common areas.
Once you're seated, the mask can be removed.
Masks will be provided at the door if you do not have one
- Sanitize your hands when you enter the building.
- Wash and sanitize your hands often. There are plenty of sanitizer stations throughout the building.
- If you have to cough or sneeze, do so into your elbow and sanitize immediately.
- Always stay six feet apart; no close talking.
- Refrain from shaking hands and hugging; a distanced wave will have to do.
- Families, stay together on one pew.
Sit in the shortest pew that accommodates your whole family.
- Parents, keep your children with you at all times.
This includes trips to the restroom.
- If you are single or attending church by yourself, sit at least six feet apart.
- Do not congregate in the foyer or doorways; we are trying to avoid close contact.
